Numbers of children under the age of 18yrs. diagnosed with Wilms per year:


1 < 10,000 children diagnosed with Wilms every year in North America.

7,500 children suffer from Wilms every year in North America.

250,000 children suffer from Wilms every year World-Wide.

Staging: Definition [stāj'ing]

- the determination of distinct phases or periods in the course of a disease, the life history of an orga -nism, or any biological process.
- 2. the classification of neoplasms according to the extent of the tumor.
